

**FAIRPORT POP WARNER 2008
PARENT/PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT**

Parents, family members, players and cheerleaders hereby pledge to provide support, care and encouragement to participants in Western New York Pop Warner. To conduct themselves in a manner which reflects positively on the organization and demonstrates good character by adhering to the Code of Conduct as follows:

- Encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, cheerleaders, coaches, board members and officials at every game, practice and other Pop Warner events.
- Place the emotional and physical well being of all persons above any personal desire to win.
- I understand that player/cheerleader information is confidential and will not use any player/cheerleader information for personal use (including e-mail and/or phone listings). The only parents authorized to mass email are Team Parents and Business Managers with approved communications from a Board member or Head Coach.
- Demand a drug and alcohol free sports environment, refrain from the use of alcohol, tobacco and performance enhancing substances at all Pop Warner events. Agree to follow the Fairport Central School Athletics Training Rules that provide for disciplinary procedures and actions for any student-athlete found in possession of using such substances.
- Remember that the game is for children and not adults.
- Treat other players, cheerleaders, coaches, fans, referees and Pop Warner officials with respect regardless of ability, race, sex or creed.
- Help all children enjoy the Pop Warner football and cheerleading sports experience by assisting with field operations and administrative matters, being a respectful fan, providing transportation and volunteering in any capacity that I am capable of doing.
- Participate in the main fund raiser.
- Not participate in any school sport of the same type.
- Be actively involved in 20 hours of practice immediately prior to participation or tournaments.
- Supply the head coach with a Fairport Pop Warner Medical Form upon returning from any injury or illness involving a physician's care.
- Refrain from selling, displaying or presenting in any manner, merchandise, literature or other items without prior authorization of the Board of Directors.
- Submit accurate and truthful documentation.
- Follow the procedure for parental concerns: The parent will contact their team Head Coach for assistance. The Head Coach may involve the Cheerleading Director, Athletic Director or other appropriate Director. The respective Director may present the matter to the Board of Directors for ultimate disposition.

A violation of the Code of Conduct may result in a warning, probation, suspension or expulsion from the Fairport Pop Warner program.

The Board of Directors reserves the right to make any changes to any rule, regulation or code it deems necessary for the safe and proper operation of the organization.
