VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTIONS

COACHING:

Willing to coach the fundamentals of football/cheerleading. Required to attend NYSCA, coaching courses, coaching clinics and first aid training. Follow the Code of Conduct set by the National, Regional and Fairport Pop Warner organizations.

COMMUNICATIONS:

Copying: Assistance with donating copies/distribution of necessary forms.

Media: Obtains organization and/or game information for use in the "Raider Gram, local newspaper media and Fact 12 when appropriate.

Raider Gram: Formats Raider Gram (organization newsletter) for distribution every Thursday. Articles are provided and assistance with copying/distribution is available.

Yearbook: Assistance with Yearbook Coordinator is designing/organizing yearbook for banquet distribution.

FIRST-AID – must be or be willing to become First Aide and CPR trained:

Game Day: Assistant to Safety Director with First-Aid/CPR needs at scheduled home and away football games.

Practice: Assistance with the Safety Director with First-Aid/CPR needs at practices Monday through Thursday @ Martha Brown in August; Tuesdays/Thursdays @ Kreag Road in September/October; Saturday AM @ Martha Brown; Monday through Fridays during September/October at various schools for cheerleading.

FUND RAISING

Car Wash: Coordinate or assist with cheerleading car wash from 9AM-1PM on a Saturday TBA in August.

Clothing Sale: Assist with sales in August, sorting or distribution in September.

Pizza Sales: Assist with selling pizza slices at the conclusion of Thursday night practices in August.

Raffle: Assist with distribution of raffle tickets at uniform order in June (cheer) or football equipment hand-out in July (football).
