General Equipment Information:

- Please find enclosed the "2007 Equipment Deposit" policy.
- Each player will be furnished equipment and will be fitted by their team of coaches.
- This year all parents will be offered the opportunity to purchase an all-in-one girdle for \$20 each.
- All required equipment will be distributed including a helmet, practice pants, game pants, belt, game jersey, pads and a mouth piece. You will be expected to provide football cleats and an athletic supporter. *Please bring an empty bag to store equipment.*
- Equipment will not be worn until the second week of practice at which time the players will be reminded by the coaches.
- Practice jerseys are available for purchase (\$10) at "Equipment Hand Out" & the "Clothing Sale" in August. These are previously worn practice jerseys which fit w/pads.
- If you're in need of a replacement during the season due to size, loss, etc., please contact the Equipment Managers, Dan Wetzel, (388-9491) or Joe Scalise (425-3029) who will make arrangements with you for replacement.

PRACTICE:

August

- Begins Monday, 7/30/07 - 6:00PM-8:00PM at Martha Brown Middle School.
- A mandatory safety meeting for both players and parents will be held in lieu of regular practice on Wednesday, August 8th at the FHS auditorium. The safety meeting will be combined with the season parent informational meetings. The safety information will be presented by Dr. Edward Lewis, a local pediatrician, and Andy Duncan, Director of University Sports Medicine.
- Please arrive promptly.
- Expected practice dress for the first week is t-shirts, shorts, socks and football cleats. Bring a water bottle. Coaches will advise teams when "pad" wear will begin.
- Outdoor restrooms are available near the tennis courts and back corner of the Martha Brown gym.
- Please be prompt in picking up your player at practice end.
- Should there be questionable weather, please bring your player to the field awaiting the coaches direction. If practice begins, please plan on staying with your child should the weather worsen. Their safety is our main concern.
- “Pizza Nights” have been established for every Thursday in August. After practice, pizza will be available for purchase.
- There will be two scrimmages played in August. A 'round robin' style scrimmage will be held the weekend of 8/18 at a location TBD and a bowl game the weekend of 8/25 in Syracuse.

September

- Practice schedule will begin on Tuesday/Thursday/Saturday basis after Labor Day.
- Tuesday/Thursday - 6PM-8PM at Kreg Road Park and Saturday at Martha Brown Middle School. Morning practice time will be determined individually by head coaches.

CERTIFICATION:

- Mid-August. Date TBD.
- Required/mandatory by Western NY Pop Warner. The Western NY commissioner will be certifying players which includes confirmation of paper work and weigh-in.
- Your player must attend practice on this evening in order to receive certification. By mandate, a player will not be eligible to play without certification.***
